




- English Text: This button allows users to select their text language as English.
- <u>Spanish Text</u>: This button allows users to select their text language as Spanish.
- <u>Zoom Out</u>: This button allows users to zoom out on the <u>passages</u> and <u>questions</u> to make the text smaller.
- <u>Zoom In</u>: This button allows users to zoom in on the <u>passages</u> and <u>questions</u> to make their text larger.
- <u>Full Page-Passage</u>: When selected, this button makes the passage fill the users entire screen.
- <u>Full Page-Questions</u>: When selected, this button makes the questions take up the users entire screen.

# **FOOTER BUTTONS**

- <u>Start Time</u>: This feature shows the date and time that users have started each practice exam.
- <u>End Test</u>: This button allows users to end each practice exam. After this button has been selected, automatic grading will begin and student practice exam scores will be submitted to the corresponding teacher.
- <u>Pause Button</u>: When selected, this button allows users to pause the time clock for the practice exam. This button is helpful for lunch and bathroom breaks.

- <u>Highlight Button</u>: This button allows users to highlight text within the passage. ## **QUESTION BUTTONS**



- <u>Mark For Review</u>: This button allows users to signify that they need to go back to review a question during their practice exam. After selecting this button, a flag icon will appear next to the question number.
- <u>Strikethrough</u>: This button allows users to put a line through answer choices they know are wrong. To use this feature, highlight the answer choice you would like to strikeout, and select the "strikethrough" button.
- <u>Text to Speech</u>: This button gives users the option to hear text read aloud. To use this feature, select the text you would like to hear, and click the "Text to Speech" button. This feature will only work if users are on a device that has speakers.
- <u>Question Answered Icon</u>: This icon appears next to the question number once a user has answered that question on his/her practice exam.
- <u>Notes Button</u>: When selected, this button will open up a notes document which allows users to type information to be used throughout the assessment. Users must save the notes so that they are available for reference on the next question.
